Request for Appointment (new):

Issuing Appointments and Amendments:

Wherever possible, the Program will arrange for pick-up by the authorized employer at the Edmonton or Calgary office. Staff will notify you when documents are available.

For jurisdictions outside the Edmonton and Calgary areas, staff will contact you to make arrangements for courier pick-up when the appointment packages are ready.

Dispositions of Requests for Review:

Disposition letters will be emailed to the complainant, peace officer and authorized employer during this period. The original letters will also be mailed at the conclusion of the Canada Post job action.
