Re: 2020 CPOIP and APOIP Training Dates

The Alberta Justice and Solicitor General Training Academy has identified the following training dates for the Community Peace Officer Induction Program and Alberta Peace Officer Investigators Program for 2020. Please note dates are subject to change and do not include the training dates for the transition (bridge) training for CPO2s. Additional information on the transition training will be released shortly.

Community Peace Officer Induction Program (CPOIP):

The course is delivered over 6 weeks in a single training block at the Training Academy in Edmonton. The course is for sponsored candidates currently employed by a peace officer agency or who have been offered employment contingent upon successful completion of training. The course will be offered:

March 17 – April 30, 2020 (space still available) Fall 2020 - TBD

Alberta Peace Officer Investigator Program (APOIP):

The course is delivered over 3 weeks in a single training block and is intended for individuals, primarily GOA employees, performing an investigative function that requires a peace officer appointment. The course will be officered:

August 10 – August 28, 2020

Application Forms and Fees:

- Application forms should be submitted as soon as possible; courses fill quickly and spaces
 are assigned on a first-come first-serve basis. Delivery of a particular session is dependent
 on a sufficient number of applicants.
