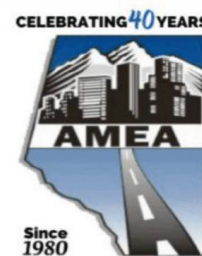

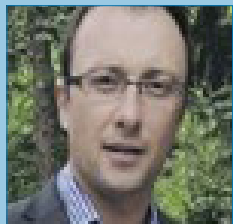

CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN (CPTED)

CPTED BASIC is a two-day course developed
to introduce the CPTED principles of Natu-
ral Surveillance, Access Control, Territorial
Reinforcement, and Maintenance. This course
focuses on reducing crime opportunities by
modifying the environment. Students will
be introduced to how the physical envi-
ronment can have a direct relationship on
human behaviour. CPTED uses various tools
to evaluate environmental conditions and
utilizes intervention methods to control
criminal and nuisance behaviour. This course
provides hands-on experience and is taught
by qualified instructors with a Professional
CPD Designation. You will receive a certificate
upon completion.
